Todd and Karin will walk the washes and check for graffiti.

Karin will get Manny the "no trespassing" sign to put up on the retaining wall at the wash.

We will have a community BBQ on October 4<sup>th</sup>. Todd will put out notices.

Todd will have a newsletter ready by the end of September.

We will have Board member elections at the October meeting. We will have ballots at the October 4<sup>th</sup> BBQ.

We will not have a September meeting due to Labor Day.
