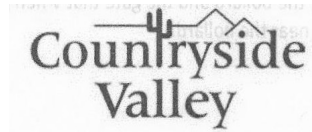

Meeting of the Countryside Valley Homeowners Association Board of Directors for 6 April 2020.

The Treasurer's Report was read and approved. We started with a balance of \$88,257.76. We had income of \$5,123.05 and expenses of \$3,523.61, leaving us with a balance of \$89,857.20.

Our new mailboxes will be ordered. They will be sandstone color. The cluster at the end of Twain St will face the street and be placed toward the back of the concrete pad. The other clusters will face away from the street.

The street sweeping has been rescheduled to May 8th.

Our prototype dog poop bag holders are ready to go but due to the coronavirus restrictions they have not been put out.

The Board voted to have a cutting board made for Alice Lyle who retired from the Community Center.
